On Earth Day 2015, Governor Malloy established the new **Governor's Council on Climate Change (GC3)**. He charged the GC3 with designing a plan to meet the state's ambitious goal of an 80% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions from 2001 levels by 2050.

During 2016, the GC3 will be gathering input from stakeholders at three different points in the planning process (May, July and October). **The first round of stakeholder engagement events will be May 5th.** The primary/central location will be in Hartford, with six satellite locations around the state (Bridgeport, Middletown, New Haven, Norwalk, Waterbury and Willimantic).

On May 5th stakeholders will learn about and provide feedback on the technologies and measures that will be modeled in the Long range Energy Alternatives Planning System (LEAP). This software tool for energy policy analysis and climate change mitigation assessment will help us understand the GHG reduction potential of various combinations of measures and technologies.
