Public Outreach Policy

Our Public Outreach Policy guides when, where, and how the NVCOG connects with residents on planning issues. This includes how the NVCOG involves the public during plan development, public outreach periods, and publication. The policy also outlines the stages of plan development as they relate to public participation.

Environmental Justice Policy

Our Environmental Justice Policy guides how the NVCOG considers the needs of minorities and low-income residents in its planning. The NVCOG aims to ensure that no COG-funded project has a disproportionate negative impact on these communities.

This policy identifies these communities in the planning region, and develops a process for considering the needs of **all** residents during the planning process.
