Roy Cavanaugh called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting was for a review of qualifications in response to the RFQ published on June 7, 2019. Eighteen responses were received.

The committee wanted to create a shortlist of 6-9 firms. Arthur Bogen proposed six firms. Jim Nardozzi expressed concern that all firms do not respond to all RFPs, therefore, he preferred more firms on the shortlist.

The committee and staff debated the merits of a larger or smaller shortlist and discussed the process for selection of qualified firms.

As a desk review of qualified LEPs, Arthur Bogen conducted a review of the submissions for the committee based on 1) representative public sector projects, 2) firm's in-house capacity, and 3) firm's prior experience with the agency.

The committee reviewed the individual firms and promoted to the shortlist by consensus.

On a motion by Sheila O'Malley, seconded by Jim Nardozzi, with all in favor, the following seven firms were selected to be placed on the shortlist effective August 1, 2019, and to be used for future RFPs issued by NVCOG, Connecticut Brownfield Land Bank, or any participating municipality or agency (in alphabetical order):
