## Save Time!

## Complete the Census form online.

- Starting in mid-March, the Census Bureau will mail you instructions for how to fill out the online form.
- You can fill out the online form on a desktop computer at home, at a library, at work, or at a friend's house.
- You can fill out the online form on a smartphone or tablet.

If you prefer, you can complete the census questions over the phone or you can mail in a paper form.

In March 2020, every mailing address in the United States will receive a letter from the U.S. Census requesting that you provide the following information:

- How many people are living in your home on April 1, 2020
- Whether your home is owned or rented
- Gender, race, age, ethnic group, and relationship status

Every person in the U.S., both citizens and non-citizens, is required by law to fill out the 2020 Census form, which you can do using a mailed-in form, the U.S. Census webpage, or phoning the Census Bureau. **You will not be asked if you are a U.S. citizen.**
