

Respond your way to the 2020 Census.

By April 1, 2020, every home will receive an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census. You will have three options for responding. All of them are easy!





Online By Phone ∃



The 2020 Census marks the first time you will be invited to respond online - even on your mobile device. The online form is available in many different languages. Visit 2020CENSUS.GOV for more information about responding online.





EVERYONE Who Resides in the United States on April 1, 2020 Needs to be Counted!

Filling out the Census Online or by Phone:

- The Census is very easy to fill out. It's only 9 questions and only one questionnaire needs to be filled out per household.
- An invitation will be mailed to each household inviting residents to participate online or by phone. Each invitation will have a
 Census ID specific to the address.
 To fill out your Consus, you will need the full names of everyone living at your address and their dates of birth. Again, only one
- To fill out your Census, you will need the full names of everyone living at your address and their dates of birth. Again, only one Census needs to be filled out per household.
- Everyone currently staying at the address as of April 1, needs to be included on the census form!
- · If someone misplaces their Census ID:
 - If you do not have your Census ID, all you will need to do is enter the exact street address with apartment number, if applicable.
- Census notifications will be sent mid-March through April. If you don't respond, a Census worker will come to your door to help you fill out the census.

Information Needed to fill out Census:

- The person in the housing unit who fills out the Census or talks to the Census taker is known as Person 1. Typically, Person 1 is the owner/co-owner or renter/co-renter of the housing unit. Person 1 answers general questions about the housing unit, including all the people living there (this also includes anyone staying with you or renting a room from you) and whether the dwelling is rented or owned. Person 1 also provides the following information about each household member:
 - Name
 - Relationship to Person 1
 - Sex
 - Age
 - · Date of Birth
 - · Race/Ethnicity
