 - a. LOTCIP Financial Update
 - i. The region has aggressively programmed LOTCIP funding, however, we are still actively seeking additional projects to program into future years
 - b. LOTCIP Guidelines Update
 - i. CTDOT released new LOTCIP guidelines – included audit strategy for project completion
 - c. MTP Update – Planning Staff is requesting feedback on regional transportation issues and goals
 - d. IIJA Update – Additional details of new and expanded funding now available – NVCOG staff can answer questions or find answers as they arise
3. Update on Hazard Mitigation Plan
 - a. Adopted by all 19 municipalities, finalizing FEMA approval now
4. Emergency Management Update
 - a. FEMA is meeting with distressed communities (as identified by CT) to discuss projects submitted to project portal
 - i. Will reply to all projects this spring
5. Municipal Shared Services Update
 - a. Food waste diversion is a viable way to reduce disposal costs – contact John DiCarlo with any potential composting sites
