Most report baseline DCIA

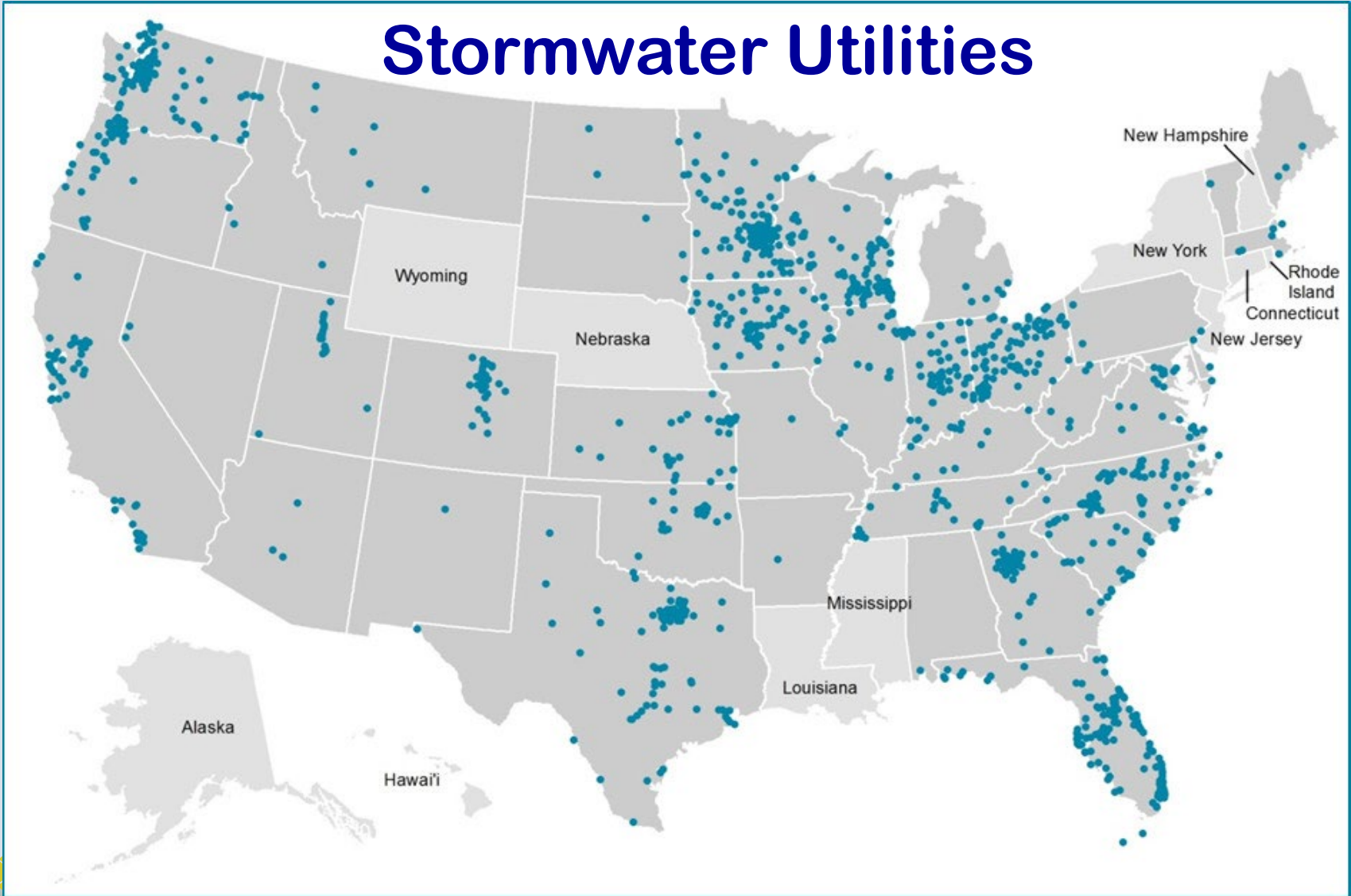


Only 2 towns report progress with DCIA disconnection
